About Boca Helping Hands

Boca Helping Hands (BHH) is a community-based non-profit that feeds those in need, provides job training and job mentoring, distributes medical and dental vouchers and provides limited financial assistance to qualified Boca Raton residents in crisis.

The Food Center serves a hot meal six days a week, with a family night dinner on Thursdays. Meals are also delivered to homebound disabled and elderly individuals. Boca Helping Hands opened its Resource Center in April 2002 with an emphasis on providing help for Boca Raton residents in crisis situations (e.g., eviction, utility cancellation) and assists working families in need with the costs of childcare

With an increased focus on client self-sufficiency, Boca Helping Hands continues to promote and highlight its job training program, which offers free classes in Hospitality, Home Health Aide, CDL (Commercial Truck Driving), Customer Service Representative and IT Help Desk Technician.

The Job Training Programs and Job Mentoring Program provide skills, coaching and guidance designed to help individuals who are seeking employment opportunities. These services complement the Boca Helping Hands food and resource programs in a continuing effort to help its clients become self-sufficient.

Boca Helping Hands has partnered with Genesis Community Health to provide services to the local community, opening a medical office in December 2015 and a dental office in December 2016. BHH supplies medical and dental vouchers to qualifying, uninsured individuals for first time visits.

In January, Charity Navigator awarded Boca Helping Hands a Four-Star Charity for the 13th Consecutive Year.
